Robin Hood Solar Farm



Qualitas Energy is proposing to develop Robin Hood Solar Farm, a c. 60MW (AC) fixed panel solar farm on a site near Robin Hood End, northwest of the town of Braintree in Essex.

The project would generate enough clean, renewable energy to power the equivalent of around 85% of households in Braintree, approximately 16,200 of the town's 19,000 homes.



This project would help to secure the UK's energy supply by creating home-grown electricity that can be connected directly into the national grid.

The project will also play an important role in helping England's important transition to a low carbon economy and will help to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in line with Braintree District Council, UK Government, and international targets, including the legally binding commitment to reach Net Zero by 2050.

Renewable energy is cheaper to generate compared to fossil fuel based technologies and its costs are less volatile to international events.

The point of connection to the national electricity network will be on-site, connecting to an existing 132kV overhead line which already passes across the land.
